DISCLOSURE

This page describes the methods of managing the website "<http://www.airporteyewear.com>" concerning the processing of the personal data of the users visiting the site. This information is provided pursuant to European Regulation 679/2016 concerning the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data, as well as the free circulation of such data (hereinafter also Regulation) for users of services on our site, which are provided via the internet. The information is not valid for other websites that can be consulted through our links, for which the Data Controller is in no way responsible.

THE DATA CONTROLLER

The Data Controller of personal data processed following consultation of our site is Centro Style S.p.A. (subsequently Data Controller), with registered office in Via GD Martinengo, 7 - Vedano Olona (VA).

PLACE, PURPOSE AND DATA COMMUNICATION

The processing operations connected to the web services of this site take place in Italy, at the aforementioned registered office of the Company and are handled by employees and collaborators of the Data Controller in charge of processing. The data deriving from the Site can be communicated to subjects that deal with the management of the site, to technological and instrumental partners of which the Controller uses for the provision of the services requested by the users, as well as to subjects whose right to access the data is recognized by law and/or secondary legislation. The personal data provided by users who request dispatch of informative material (requests for information, answers to questions, etc.) or other communications are used for the sole purpose of performing the service or provision requested and are communicated to third parties only in the case where this is necessary for that purpose.

TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED

Navigation data

During normal operation, the computer systems and software procedures adopted for the operation of this website acquire some personal data which is transmitted implicitly in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This information is not collected in order to be associated to the identified persons concerned, but by its very nature it could be processed and associated with data held by third parties in order to identify the users.

This category of data include the IP addresses and domain names of the computers used by users connecting to the website, the URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in reply, the numerical code indicating the state of the response from the server (OK, error, etc.) and other parameters concerning the user's operating system or computer environment.

This data is used only to obtain anonymous statistical information on the use of the website and to check that it is running correctly, and is canceled immediately after processing. The data could be used to ascertain responsibility in case of hypothetical computer crimes against the site.

Data provided voluntarily by the user

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of e-mails to the addresses indicated in this website implies the subsequent acquisition of the sender's e-mail address, required to reply to any request, as well as any other personal data included in the e-mail.

Specific summary information notices are progressively given or displayed in the pages of the website used for specific services on request.

COOKIES POLICY

This website uses cookies and similar technologies to guarantee the correct functioning of procedures and improve the experience of using online applications. Cookies are text files that are entered on the hard drive of a computer. Cookies are used to streamline the analysis of web traffic and report when a specific website is visited, and allow web applications to send information to individual users. Below we provide detailed information on the use of cookies and similar technologies, on how they are used by the Owner and on how to manage them.

The Data Controller:

- "Technical" cookies

These cookies are functional to navigation and guarantee the safe and efficient surfing of the site. The cookies in this category include both persistent and session cookies. Without these cookies, the site or parts of it, may not work properly. Therefore, they are always used, regardless of user preferences. Cookies of this type are always sent from our domain. The duration of these cookies is strictly limited to the work session or they see a longer stay in order to remember the visitor's choices. Disabling strictly necessary cookies can compromise the user experience and navigation of the website.

- "Analytical" cookies

They are cookies used to collect and analyze the traffic and use of a website anonymously. These are third-party cookies collected and managed anonymously to monitor and improve the performance of the host site (performance cookies). - "social plug-in" cookies:

These are parts of the visited page generated directly by the aforementioned sites and integrated into the page of the host site. - "Remarketing" cookies:

These cookies are persistent, i.e. fragments of information that remain longer and that are placed on the hard disk of the user's computer to remain there until the "cookie" is deleted. They allow you to show ads to users, who have already visited the site, when they browse the web. The site uses other persistent third-party cookies to monitor visits related to the digital activities performed. The Remarketing cookies used are those of Google.

TOTAL OR PARTIAL DISABLING OF COOKIES

The user can decide whether to accept cookies using the settings on his or her browser.

The total or partial disabling of technical cookies may compromise the use of the site features reserved for registered users. On the contrary, accessing public content is also possible after completely disabling cookies.

Disabling "third party" or profiling cookies does not affect browsing in any way.

The setting can be defined specifically for different websites and web applications. In fact, the best browsers allow you to place different settings for "proprietary" and "third-party" cookies.

Below we indicate how to disable cookies in some browsers.

Google Chrome

1. Select the Chrome menu icon ☰.
2. Select Settings.
3. At the bottom of the page, select Show advanced settings.
4. In the "Privacy" section, select Content settings.
5. Select Prevent sites from setting data.
6. Select Finish.

Safari

1. Go to the Safari menu (icon at the top right of the browser) and select Preferences.
2. In the pop-up window that opens, select the Security icon (padlock).
3. Under the "Accept cookies" item, select the "Never" button.

Firefox

1. Click the ☰ menu button and select Options.
2. Select the Privacy panel.
3. Under History settings: select use custom settings.
4. To enable cookies, check the box **Accept cookies from sites**; to deactivate remove the mark from the box.

Explorer

1. Go to the Explorer menu and click on the Settings button and then on Advanced Options.
2. Click the Cookie tab and move the slider up to block all cookies or down to allow them all and then click OK.

OPTIONAL PROVISION OF DATA

Apart from the data specified as navigation data, the user is free to provide personal data to request the services offered by the company. Failure to provide such data may make it impossible to obtain the requested service.
